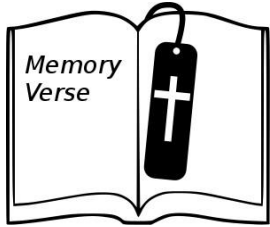

- Wed. 18<sup>th</sup> September, 19:30: Bible Study in the Anglican Centre resumes, come and join in even if you have never tried it before.

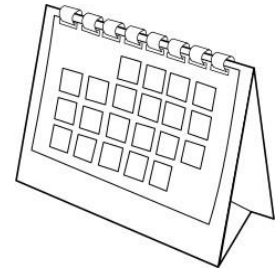

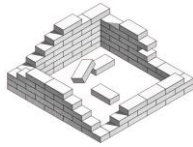

## Works in progress



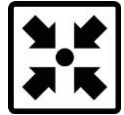
- 1) the office in the Anglican Centre is getting a new door (thank you to those of you who have contributed to that)
