## Children

The number and ages of children (and parenting styles) vary from session to session School aged children can be engaged in conversation to keep them occupied and safe (from road and passing adults) Pre school children to be gathered indoors around an activity at the table – Kara and Mohaned Babies usually still in pushchairs or strapped to backs
